# Ride to rescue of orangutans

ELEVEN northern beaches cyclists will ride from Canberra to Sydney this month to raise awareness of the "soul destroying" ruination of orangutan habitat, and money for an organisation battling against it.

Deforestation, illegal logging and uncontrollable fires have destroyed more than 80 per cent of the orangutan habitat over the past two decades, according to ride organiser and renowned wildlife artist Geri Roggiero, of Collaroy.

The group will raise money for Indonesian not-for-profit, community-based Friends of the National Parks Foundation, which helps save threatened species including orang-utans, the cloud leopard and Bali's "national emblem", the Bali starling.

"It's soul-destroying seeing the habitats of these magnificent creatures being wiped out as a result of human greed on the one hand and ignorance at the damage that is being done on the other," Mrs Roggiero said. She visited Borneo in 2005 and saw firsthand the destruction caused by the planting of palm oil crops that threaten plant and animal species.

"I urge all Australians to not only avoid products with palm oil, but to, more importantly, support the relentless work of the Friends of the National Parks Foundation," she said.

The 330km ride - to be held on March 17 and 18 - is in its third year.
